- -Removing and collecting linens for laundering and transporting them to designated areas.
- -Checking guest rooms for needed repairs and/or items to be replaced.
- -Cleaning rugs, carpets, and upholstered furniture using a vacuum cleaner or carpet cleaner.
- -Dusting furniture and equipment.
- -Emptying wastebaskets and cleaning them inside and out.
- -Cleaning tiled floors with the use of brooms and mops.
- -Using chemical-based products to clean tubs, sinks, countertops, mirrors, toilets, door panels, shower curtains, and other property fixtures such as exterior lighting railings, and pool area.
- -Replenishing trash bags, soaps, bathroom items, and other supplies.
- -Transporting all trash and waste to disposal areas, as instructed.
- -Removing items from refrigerator and microwave.
- -Cleaning refrigerator, microwave, and any additional appliances inside and out.
- -Loading and unloading dishes from dishwasher, drying dishes, and putting them away in the proper places.
- -Demonstrate a high level of customer service. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests.
- -Keep supervisor/manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency

situations, damages, and potential safety hazards.

- -Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all additional training courses.
